HHS-CDC **Comprehensive STD Prevention Systems** \$ 405,035 12/22/05 Funds to administer the Iowa Sexually Transmitted Disease program. Funds are used to provide disease prevention education, disease intervention/follow-up, and laboratory testing. Seventy STD clinics across Iowa are in place with these funds as well. **USDA-FNS** Women, Infant, Children \$ 3,969,919 12/2/05 Grant for Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children to provide WIC services including food to low income eligible lowan's.
