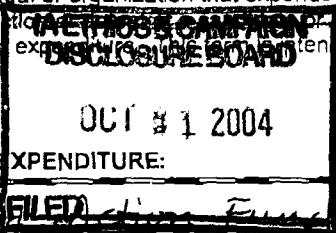

INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE
BY AN INDIVIDUAL OR PERMANENT ORGANIZATION WITHOUT PRIOR
APPROVAL OR COORDINATION WITH A CANDIDATE OR COMMITTEE

Iowa Code section 68A.404 requires an individual or organization that expends in excess of \$750 in the aggregate to expressly advocate the election of a candidate or ballot issue to file a statement within 48 hours of the independent expenditure. Expenditures are intended to serve those purposes.
