



## Response to DE Employee Request for Consent to Sell

### Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Ms. Walkup seeks permission to sell the service of teaching the following credit courses for Drake University (Drake): Intro to Special Education (SPED 120/220), Consultation and In-Service Development (SPED 278), and Supervision of Special Education Instruction (SPED 221).

Drake University is a private postsecondary institution whose teacher and administrator preparation programs must be approved by this agency. The students who take the Drake courses are students in Drake's teacher preparation program.

Ms. Walkup is the IDE consultant for the education of homeless children and youth in Iowa's public school districts. She is not a member of IDE staff whose responsibility it is to review, assess, and recommend for approval practitioner preparation programs.

Therefore, the sale of the service of teaching the above course will not cause Susan Walkup to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
